

RMRHA Educational Scholarship Application Information and Process

Information

- Educational funds are awarded to assist in starting a program of study OR continuing a program of study at a post high-school institution
- Recipient(s) will be determined by the RMRHA Board of Directors
- The RMRHA Board of Directors will announce the winner(s) of the RMRHA Educational Scholarships on December 17, 2020 at the Annual RMRHA Members Board Meeting to happen via Zoom at 6:30 pm
- Applicants must turn in their application packet to Sue Glenn by midnight, November 25, 2020
- The scholarship awards given on December 17, 2020 may be used for the semester/trimester beginning on or around January 1, 2021. If the applicant wishes to receive an award for the 2021/2022 school year, he or she may do so by indicating that on the application and application will be considered for the total of 3 semesters or equivalent trimesters

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a current member of RMRHA
- Applicant must be attending, or planning to attend, an undergraduate degree in a two-year or four-year institution, trade, or technical school
- Previous recipients of the RMRHA Scholarship can re-apply as long as education is continuing, even if place of education is changing
- Applicants must be either a graduating high school senior at time of application or registered in a program of study and have completed at least one year of post high-school education at time of application

RMRHA Educational Scholarship Application Information and Process (continued)

Application will include the following:

- Application form located on the RMRHA website
- Letter of recommendation from a horsewoman or horseman
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher or advisor
- Letter of recommendation from someone outside the horse industry (employer, clergy, mentor)
- Current year academic record
- Statement from you of your equine background
- List of community involvement and/or activities
- Statement of sense of direction for furthering education

Funding

- Funds will be disbursed directly to the school of choice
- If awarded a scholarship, recipient will be asked to provide the following information to the RMRHA Treasurer for release of funds:
 - School Name
 - School Financial Aid Office address
 - School Contact
 - School Contact's phone number
